what is cub scouting?

In 1930 the Boy Scouts of America (BSA) launched a home - and neighborhood - centered program for boys. A key element of the program is an emphasis on caring, nurturing relationships between boys and their parents, adult leaders, and friends.

Currently, Cub Scouting is the largest of the BSA's three membership divisions. (Cub Scouts, Boy Scouting & Venturing.)

9 purposes of cub scouting

- ▶ **Positively influence character development and encourage spiritual growth**
- ▶ **Help boys develop habits and attitudes of good citizenship**
- ▶ **Encourage good sportsmanship and pride in growing strong in mind and body**
- ▶ **Improve understanding within the family**
- ▶ **Strengthen boys' ability to get along with other boys and respect other people**
- ▶ **Foster a sense of personal achievement by helping boys develop new interests and skills**
- ▶ **Show how to be helpful and do one's best**
- ▶ **Provide fun and exciting new things to do**
- ▶ **Prepare boys to become Boy Scouts**

Funding and costs

- ▶ **This year's annual dues for each Cub Scout is \$65**
- ▶ **Popcorn sale in fall is only fund raising activity**
 - ▶ Funds used for activities, equipment, rental etc.

Reminder to Parents of 1st Grader Boys

- ▶ **This note is to introduce you to the cub scouting program**
 - ▶ **Pack meetings are typically the last Thursday of the month**
 - ▶ Starting in Sept and going through May
 - ▶ Over summer there are camps available
 - ▶ Over summer there are also activities such as going to baseball game
 - ▶ **First graders start in Tiger cubs**
 - ▶ One pack meeting per month (at Heatherstone)
 - ▶ One/Two Den meetings per month (at rotating parents house)
 - ▶ One "Go See It" activity such as visiting radio station, Fire house etc.
 - ▶ **Parents share the Tiger experience with child and attend all meetings**
 - ▶ One parent/guardian should be with child at all functions
 - ▶ **Sign up will be when school starts**
